STUDENT BURSARY RULES and APPLICATION

The Elora Sculpture Project will award one bursary in the amount of \$500.00 to an eligible artist whose work is selected for the exhibition in 2016.

Applicants must be Canadian residents, enrolled in, and attending, a qualifying program at a Canadian University or College at some time during 2016. Proof of enrolment will be required.

Qualifying programs include Fine Arts, Applied Arts, Architecture, Design, Crafts and related skilled trades.

Entries must meet all the requirements as described in the Call For Submissions, and applicants must complete the Entry Form as well as this application.

The winning applicant's entry will be selected by the jury using the criteria listed in the Call For Submissions.

The jury may choose works from more than one eligible student for exhibition but only one bursary shall be awarded. The jury may also choose to withhold the bursary if no suitable submissions are received.

The \$500.00 award will be paid after installation of the sculpture at its designated site in Elora, Ontario in May 2016.
